San Diego Statistics

- Population of 1.26 million people, making it the 8th largest city in the USA.
- 3,906 people per square mile
- 37.4% of families speak a language other than English at home
- Average annual precipitation is 9.5 inches
- 14.6% of people live below the poverty level
- San Diego County's high housing prices and low wages make it the second least affordable area to live in the USA.
- Nightly, there are 4,500 homeless people. There are about 2,000 beds available to the homeless. This leaves about 55% sleeping on the streets.

Only those students who have turned in their registration form along with a \$50 deposit will be guaranteed a spot on the trip. The total cost for the trip is \$300 for students active in the life of the church and in the Youth Ministry with participation in worship, Sunday morning Atmosphere, FX and Sunday night Youth Ministry and fundraising events. Non-active students cost is \$400. The cost includes all activities, transportation and food during our time away. Your student will only need money for fast food meals traveling to and from San Diego, food at Sea World and for any souvenirs they would like to purchase.

San Diego

As the second most populous city in California, San Diego offers its residents city living, as well as close proximity to ocean waters, national forests, and a terrain that varies from foothills to mountains. The city itself is home to nearly 1.3 million people and has endless activities for both residents and tourists. But like many other large urban cities, this city wrestles with pressing socio-economic issues. Many families work hard to make ends meet, with multiple family members holding several jobs each. Federal statistics report that 10.9% of the population lives below the poverty line and over 50% of homes have critical housing needs. The homeless population continues to grow, along with increasing low income neighborhoods and dilapidated housing.

Our Goal

The goal of YouthWorks! Is to partner with local ministries and programs that seek to address the very basic needs of San Diego's residents. ELEVATE Youth Ministry students and leaders will work alongside numerous social service organizations to support children's ministries, the elderly and the homeless.

Evening Activities

Evening activities are designed to give participants insight into the lives of local residents and the culture of the area. Our activities may include a community educational experience, attending a local church service, a community cookout and spending an evening at the beach.
